Tamaso Johnson serves as the Public Policy Director for the Washington State Coalition Against Domestic Violence (WSCADV). WSCADV is a statewide membership organization of close to 70 direct service providers assisting survivors and their children. Tamaso Johnson leads WSCADV's local and state legislative advocacy efforts to increase the safety as well as autonomy for survivors of domestic and sexual violence. In this position, he also aims to promote accountability and to address the root causes of violence. Prior to joining WSCADV, Tamaso led policy advocacy efforts at the DC Coalition Against Domestic Violence in Washington, DC.

Tamaso has led successful advocacy to secure and increase funding for victim services and housing, reduce abusers' access to firearms, safeguard survivor privacy, and improve systems response to immigrant survivors. Since 2009, he has been a volunteer with the WomensLaw.org national email hotline, reviewing and responding to questions regarding domestic violence legal matters.

Tamaso holds a J.D. from the George Washington University Law School, and a B.A. in International Studies from the University of Washington.
